


State Swimming

Intention to apply: Year 5 entry to an opportunity class in 2025 (Year 4 2024 students only)

Dear Parents/Carers,

Opportunity classes can provide intellectual stimulation by grouping together high potential and gifted students in Years 5 and 6. Parents/carers apply when students are in Year 4 for placement in Years 5 and 6. It is a 2-year program. Tamworth Public School has a Year 5/6 opportunity class.

Opportunity Class Placement Test

Applications for opportunity class placement are considered on the results of the Opportunity Class Placement Test. Students who wish to be considered for placement are required to sit the Opportunity Class Placement Test on Thursday 1 August 2024.

How to apply

Parents/carers apply online between Thursday 4 April and Monday 20 May 2024 at: education.nsw.gov.au/oc.

You must use your own email address and not one belonging to your child. You must submit only one application for each child. Late applications are not usually accepted.

If you do not have internet access you can apply at a public library or at your child's school. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Selective Education Unit for assistance after 4 April 2024.




