

TPS School Uniform Policy

The summer and winter items of clothing listed below are the official school uniform. Tamworth Public School uniform, including a school hat, must be worn by all students.

Students will wear sports uniform three days per week, formal uniform 2 days per week.

By agreement with its community, this school is a 'full uniform' school in accordance with the Department of Education School Uniform Policy

The school uniform promotes a sense of belonging for students and creates a positive identity for the school community as well as contributing to personal safety of all students.

GIRLS' SUMMER UNIFORM

Blue/white check princess line tunic with a blue tab tie and white peter pan collar Or navy shorts and TPS blue button up shirt with navy piping Short white socks Black shoes (NOT multi-coloured footwear)

GIRLS' WINTER UNIFORM

Blue/gold plaid tunic White long-sleeved blouse Tie - same plaid as tunic Navy blue stockings or long navy blue socks Navy slacks with white long-sleeved blouse Jumper - royal blue fleecy V-neck top with school emblem Black shoes (NOT multi-coloured footwear)

GIRLS' SPORT UNIFORM

Sports uniform is worn on sports/PE days which will be three days per week Royal blue skirt with two inverted pleats front and back Or royal blue rugby knit shorts School sports shirt (royal blue with gold trimmings) Short white socks Royal blue track pants (not shiny) to match school jumper Sports shoes, white or black - practical and plain rather than trendy. Preferably non-marking soles for use on tennis court Year 6 sports shirts PSSA representative jumper can only be worn on Stage sport days

BOYS' SUMMER UNIFORM

Grey shorts Blue short-sleeved shirt Grey socks with royal blue and gold stripes Black shoes/boots (NOT multi-coloured footwear)

BOYS' WINTER UNIFORM

Grey long trousers Blue long-sleeved shirt Tie - same plaid as girls' tunic Grey socks with royal blue and gold stripes Black shoes/boots (NOT multi-coloured footwear) Jumper - royal blue fleecy V-neck top with school emblem

BOYS' SPORT UNIFORM

Sports uniform is worn on sports/PE days which will be three days per week Royal blue rugby knit shorts School sports shirt (royal blue with gold trimming) Royal blue track pants (not shiny) to match school jumper White socks Sports shoes, white or black - practical and plain rather than trendy Preferably non-marking soles for use on tennis court Year 6 sports shirts PSSA representative jumper can only be worn on Stage sports days

SCHOOL HATS

Broad brimmed blue school hats or blue bucket hat with logo. As a "Sun Safe' school we have an ongoing campaign to ensure children wear a hat at all times in the playground.

SUMMER/WINTER UNIFORM TIME OF YEAR

Summer uniform for boys and girls are to be worn in Terms 1 and 4. There may be a changeover period at the beginning of Term 2 and Term 4 depending on weather conditions at the Principal's discretion.

Winter uniform for boys and girls are to be worn in Terms 2 and 3. There may be a changeover period at the beginning of Term 2 and 4 depending on weather conditions and at the Principal's discretion.

JEWELLERY/HAIR/MAKEUP

Earrings are to be simple studs or sleepers. No necklaces/bracelets/anklets or rings (exception is cygnet rings or medical bracelets/necklaces) No nail polish/fake nails/makeup Hair bows/hair accessories must be white or navy blue. Long hair below shoulder height must be tied up

JACKETS

School Jackets are optional - royal blue/gold nylon zip front jacket These jackets can be worn with all uniforms
