

Beach to Bush 2022 Tour

Our school will be participating in the Beach to Bush 2022 tour on 23rd November 2022. Since 1994 Beach to Bush enthusiastic and interactive volunteer lifesavers have been visiting schools in rural and remote areas of NSW to educate primary aged students about beach and water safety. So far they have delivered messages

to 266,610 students and 1,926 schools. Beach to Bush provide a 45 minute presentation focus on beach and inland water safety to students from K-6. Students will learn about general beach safety, sun safety, rips and waves, sea creatures, basic first aid, rescues and getting help from a

lifeguard. Their presentations align with the NSW curriculum.
