Visible Learning & Learner Qualities

Over the past 3 years, teachers have been introducing students to Visible Learning, using Learning Intentions & Success Criteria, along with Feedback to help students play a vital role in their learning.

Across term 1, Teachers and classes are being introduced to the Tamworth Public School Learner Qualities and their associated characters. Learner Qualities describe a persons inclination or ability to use particular skills when faced with problems to solve, ideas to evaluate or decisions to make. Using these ways of thinking will help students to negotiate a range of situations and scenarios both in and outside of school.

Our staff were surveyed and consulted on what dispositions they thought were the most important for all students to embody. Throughout the term students will be introduced to each of the 5 characters over a two week period. In class they will go through various learning activities and scenarios explaining to them how they can use that disposition at school and at home.

Our first character and disposition for week 3 & 4 is Resilient Rosella.

Resilient Rosella

Students are learning that being resilient means:

- · I Keep trying when things are challenging
- · I Know that mistakes can help me learn
- · I Can manage my emotions when things do not go to plan.

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VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!! RETURN AND EARN

As part of our school recycling program we collect and recycle drink containers such as the juice poppers, milk /Up and Go cartons, water and Chill J bottles. Theses containers are recycled through the community "Return and Earn' program.

Recycling many of our drink containers that may have ended up in landfill, we are able to raise between \$15-\$20 a week. This money is used by the school on new environmental initiatives.

We were hoping to recruit some keen parents/grandparents, who would like to volunteer to help with this task. The job would require-

* Helping out twice a term

* Collecting 2/3 plastic tubs full of sorted recycle drink containers from school on a day that suits you

* Putting them through a Return and Earn machine/or the new automated depo in Taminda
