SORA is an online reading platform that is aligned to the school's Library Oliver system. There are thousands of books that students can "borrow" and read on devices like laptops, iPads and smartphones. Books are borrowed for a two week period, just like real library books. Students can access the SORA collection by going wo <a href="https://www.soraapp.com">www.soraapp.com</a>

Students may need to sign in using their department email address, which is the student's username followed by (eg harry.potter@educaiton.nsw.edu.au)Once in the site, at the bottom of the page, it will ask for a setup code.

Our set code is "nswprimaryau". Once the setup code is entered, you can then find Tamworth Public School on the dropdown menu list. Click on our school and then you are at the Homepage, where you can browse and borrow.

The Shelf section shows students which books they have borrowed and when they're due to be returned.

SORA is a great option if you are going away on holidays and don't want to pack a lot of bulky books.

We are excited to announce our school is now using School Bytes which offers a simplified digital system for school payments and parent/carer communication. The changes you see are:

- The students **Statement of Account** and **payment reminders** will be sent directly to parents/caregivers via email.
- Emails will be sent to you from noreply@mail.schoolbytes.education.
- The student's **Statement of Account** email will include the **make a payment** button that will take you to the school's online payment portal.
- If the activity involves a cost, the **make a payment** button will allow you to pay securely, quickly and easily via credit or debit card after granting permission (Visa and Mastercard only).
- Online forms including permission notes, will be sent to you directly via School Bytes with a link enclosed. Select the link to open the secure online form.
- The online form will have information about the activity with a section for a digital signature (either with a mouse or your finger) prior to submitting.
- The **make a payment** button will allow you to pay securely, quickly and easily via credit or debit card (Visa and Mastercard only).

**Please note:** Transactions made through the online payment portal will appear on your bank statement as 0SCHOOLSONLINE 0000 PARRAMATTA AU.



Summit Holiday Kids Club is for kids in Year K-6 in the October school holidays.






# **Great news!**
